5. Copy of Aadhar Card.
6. Bank A/c Number
7. Voter ID card.
8. Affidavit of gap.

FOR GIRLS STUDENTS

Only girl's students who are bonafide Himachali are eligible for exemption of tuition fees.

NOTE: The candidates who have passed the previous exams from another Board/University must submit the following documents.

1. Eligibility certificate from the H.P. Board/University declaring equivalence of the course studies by them for the purpose of admission.

2. Original Migration certificate from Board/University from where they passed.
3. Detailed marks sheet of exams passed.
4. Character certificate (in original) from Head of Institution last attended.

NOTE: All the original certificates must be produced at the time of admission and addition attested copies of all certificate must be deposited.



प्रवेश के लिए दिशा निर्देश

नोट :-सत्र 2025-26 में वी.ए./बी. कॉम प्रथम वर्ष के लिए पाठ्यक्रम, हिमाचल प्रदेश विश्वविद्यालय व हिमाचल प्रदेश सरकार की नवीनतम अधिसूचना व दिशा निर्देशों के अनुसार होगा।

प्रवेश हेतु पात्रता:-

1. बी.ए. में प्रवेश लेने के लिए छात्र का 10+2 की परीक्षा में सभी विषयों में न्यूनतम 33 प्रतिशत अंक के साथ पास होना अनिवार्य है।
2. कला संकाय वाले सभी छात्रों के लिए बी. कॉम में प्रवेश लेने के लिए 10+2 में गणित तथा अर्थशास्त्र में से किसी एक विषय का अध्ययन करना अनिवार्य है।
3. वाणिज्य समूहों के छात्रों के लिए बी. कॉम में प्रवेश के लिए न्यूनतम 40 प्रतिशत निर्धारित की गई है।
4. इसके अलावा छात्राओं बी. कॉम में प्रवेश के लिए न्यूनतम 33 प्रतिशत निर्धारित की गई है।

आवश्यक दस्तावेज:-

बायोडेटा, अंडरटेकिंग तथा पी.टी.ए. प्रपत्र के साथ पूरा प्रवेश प्रपत्र निम्नलिखित दस्तावेजों के साथ प्रस्तुत किया जाना चाहिए।

1. दो पासपोर्ट आकार के छात्र के फोटो और दो पासपोर्ट आकार के माता पिता या अभिभावक के फोटो।
2. मैट्रिक प्रमाण पत्र के साथ-साथ अन्य सभी मूल प्रमाण पत्र उनकी फोटो प्रतियों के साथ उपलब्ध होने चाहिए।
3. हि. प्र. अधिवास डोमिसाइल प्रमाण पत्र केवल छात्राओं के लिए जरूरी है।
4. शुल्क छूट तथा आयु में छूट पाने के लिए 40 प्रतिशत विकलांगता प्रमाण पत्र और श्रेणी प्रमाण पत्र प्रस्तुत करता अनिवार्य होगा।
5. पुराने छात्रों के पास पंजीकरण रजिस्ट्रेशन कार्ड की फोटो प्रति होना अनिवार्य है।
6. विद्यार्थियों को किसी भी पाठ्यक्रम के पहले वर्ष में प्रवेश लेने के लिए पिछले संस्थान के प्रमुख से मूल चरित्र प्रमाण पत्र को प्रस्तुत करना होगा। ऐसे छात्र के मामले में जिनकी पढ़ाई में एक या अधिक वर्षों का अंतराल हो, उसे किसी राजपत्रित अधिकारी या

संबंधित गांव के प्रधान से मूल चरित्र प्रमाण पत्र को प्रस्तुत करना होगा, चरित्र प्रमाण पत्र प्रवेश की तिथि से छः महीने पहले की अवधि का नहीं होना चाहिए।

7. हि. प्र. शिक्षा बोर्ड और विश्वविद्यालय के अलावा अन्य शिक्षा बोर्ड और विश्वविद्यालय के छात्रों को प्रवेश हेतु प्रवास माइग्रेशन प्रमाण पत्र अथवा शपथ पत्र की मूल प्रति प्रस्तुत करनी होगी। झूठा शपथ पत्र प्रस्तुत करना कानूनी अपराध है।

महत्वपूर्ण जानकारी:-

1. सभी छात्र छात्राओं की अपनी ई, मेल, आई. डी. होनी अनिवार्य है। प्रत्येक छात्र अपने प्रवेश पत्र पर अपना बैंक खाता नम्बर तथा आधार नम्बर व मतदाता पहचान पत्र का नम्बर अंकित करे तथा इनकी एक-एक प्रति अवश्य होनी चाहिए।
2. सभी छात्र छात्राओं के लिए यह अवश्यक है कि वह अपना फोन न. छात्र के प्रवेश पत्र पर अवश्य लिखे ताकि आवश्यकता पड़ने पर उनसे आसानी से संपर्क किया जा सके।

प्रवेश प्रक्रिया:-

1. प्रवेश के लिए महाविद्यालय सूची पत्र प्रॉस्पेक्टस में उपलब्ध प्रपत्र फार्म पर ही आवेदन करना होगा।
2. छात्र छात्राओं को सभी नियमों तथा पात्रता शर्तों को ध्यान से पढ़ने के बाद स्वयं के हस्तलेखन में आवेदन पत्र भरना होगा।
3. अभिभावकों को प्रवेश के लिए आना आवश्यक है। अभिभावकों के हस्ताक्षर ही मान्य होंगे।
4. प्रवेश पत्र में दिए गए अनुक्रम के अनुसार ही प्रमाण पत्रों को लगाना होगा।
5. प्रवेश प्रपत्र पर प्रवेश समिति के अनुमोदन के बाद छात्र को उस समिति के संयोजक तथा उसके बाद अन्तिम प्रवेश समिति का अनुमोदन लेना होगा।
6. अनुमोदन के बाद निर्धारित तिथि पर फीस जमा नहीं होती तो उसका प्रवेश रद्द माना जायेगा।

प्रवेश हेतु नियम:-

1. महाविद्यालय में प्रवेश केवल प्रवेश समिति के अनुमोदन पर ही होगा।
2. प्रवेश केवल निर्धारित पात्रता शर्तों के पूरा करने पर ही किया जाएगा।
3. बी.ए./बी.कॉम में प्रवेश लेने वाले छात्रों की अधिकतम आयु 23 वर्ष और छात्रों की 25 वर्ष निर्धारित की गई। इससे अधिक आयु वाले छात्रों को कुलपति की अनुमति

द्वारा 6 महीने तक की अधिकतम छूट दी जा सकती है। इसके अतिरिक्त अनुसूचित जाति व अनुसूचित जनजाति के छात्रों को 3 साल तक की अतिरिक्त छूट दी जा सकती है।

4. सभी प्रवेश हिमाचल प्रदेश विश्वविद्यालय की अनुमति के बिना अनंतिम/अल्पकालिक है।
5. प्रवेश और शुल्क संरचना के सभी नियम हि.प्र. विश्वविद्यालय के निर्देशों के अनुसार ही बदले और संशोधित किए जा सकते हैं।
6. प्रवेश के समय सभी मूल प्रमाण पत्र साथ लाएं।
7. अध्ययन में एक या अधिक वर्षों का अंतराल है तो कारण बताने हेतु एक शपथ पत्र प्रस्तुत करना होगा।
8. प्रवेश पाने वाले हर छात्र को पी.टी.ए. निधि में 500 रुपये प्रति सत्र का भुगतान करना होगा।
9. छात्रों को ट्यूशन फीस में छूट के लिए हि.प्र. वीनाफाइंड प्रमाण पत्र की एक प्रमाणित प्रतिलिपि साथ लानी होगी।
10. विकलांग छात्र के ट्यूशन फीस में छूट के लिए 40 प्रतिशत विकलांगता प्रमाण पत्र की प्रमाणित प्रति संलग्न करनी होगी।
11. जिन छात्रों ने पहले सत्र या वर्ष की पढ़ाई किसी अन्य विश्वविद्यालय से की है और अगर वह हि.प्र. विश्वविद्यालय द्वारा निर्धारित टी.डी.सी. II और टी.डी.सी. III में प्रवेश लेना चाहते हैं तो पहले उसके द्वारा अध्ययन किए गए पाठ्यक्रम की समक्षता हि.प्र. विश्वविद्यालय शिमला द्वारा निर्धारित की जाएगी, तत्पश्चात ही उसका प्रवेश मान्य माना जाएगा।
12. जो छात्र हि.प्र. बोर्ड व हि.प्र. विश्वविद्यालय के अलावा अन्य शिक्षा बोर्ड अन्य विश्वविद्यालय से पढ़कर आए हैं उन्हें प्रवेश लेने हेतु माइग्रेशन प्रमाण पत्र की मूल प्रति प्रस्तुत करनी होगी न्यूनतम पात्रता शर्तों के अतिरिक्त केवल उन छात्रों को जो राष्ट्रीय ओपन स्कूल में 10+2 सभी विषयों में पास होंगे उन्हें ही बी.ए. तथा बी.कॉम में प्रवेश दिया जायेगा।

CONDITIONS FOR MIGRATION CASES

1. The Original Migration certificate of a Board/University from which the candidate migrates to this College will have to be submitted.
2. Migration from another college affiliated to HPU and vice versa is governed by the HP University rules.
3. The migrating student must bring with him/her: I) Lecture attendance statement. II) Statement of marks obtained in the Mid Term Tests.III) Character Certificate from the Head of the Institution last attended.
4. After the migration has been sanctioned and notified by the University the student must join the new college within the given period of time i.e.by the date given by the University.
5. On joining a new college, the student will have to pay all the funds for full year whereas the Tuition fee will be payable from the month of his joining.
6. No migration certificate can be issued unless the student is registered with the other University.
7. A candidate migrating from this college will have to obtain clearance from the college office, Library, NCC, NSS, sports and other concerned departments.

CAREER GUIDANCE AND PLACEMENT CELL

Career Guidance and Placement Cell is functioning in the college which includes the team of dedicated teachers. The focus of the team is to guide the students regarding self-assessments, career explorations and goal setting. Time to time lectures are organised with innovative themes/ titles in the benefit of the students.

UG PROGRAMME

Annual System provides an opportunity for the students to choose courses from the prescribed courses comprising core, elective/minor or skill based courses. The courses can be evaluated following the grading system, which is considered to be better than the conventional marks system. Therefore, it is necessary to introduce uniform grading system in the entire higher education in India. This will benefit the students to move across institutions within India to begin with and across countries. The uniform grading system will also enable potential employers in assessing the performance of the candidates. In order to bring uniformity in evaluation system and computation of the Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) based on student's performance in examinations, the UGC has formulated the guidelines to be followed.

Outline of Annual System

- **Discipline Specific Core (DSC) Course:** A course, which should compulsorily be studied by a candidate as a core requirement is termed as a core course.
- **Elective Course:** Generally a course which can be chosen from a pool of courses and which may be very specific or specialized or advances or supportive to be discipline/subject of study or which provides and extended scope or which enables an exposure to some other discipline/subject/domain or nurtures the candidate's proficiency/ skill is called an Elective Course.
- **Discipline Specific (DSE) Course** (2 each for regular courses): Elective courses may be offered by the main discipline/subject of study is referred to as Discipline Specific Elective. The University/Institute may also offer discipline related Elective courses of interdisciplinary nature (to be offered by main discipline/subject of study).
- **Dissertation/Project Work:** An elective course of 6 credits designed to acquire special/advanced knowledge, such as supplement study/support study to a project work, and a candidate studies such a courses on his own with an advisory support by a teacher/faculty member is called dissertation/project work. A project/Dissertation work be given in lieu of a discipline specific elective paper.
- **Generic Elective Course (GEC):** An elective course chosen generally from an unrelated discipline/ subject, with an intention to seek exposure to other subjects/disciplines is called a Generic Elective Courses. P.S.: A core course offered in a discipline/subject may be treated as an elective by other discipline/subject and vice versa and such elective may also be referred to as Generic Elective.

Ability Enhancement Courses (AEC)/ Competency Improvement Courses/Skill Development Courses/Foundation Courses: The Ability Enhancement (AE) Courses may be of two kinds: AE Compulsory Course (AECC) and AE Elective Courses (AEEC) "AECC" Courses are the courses based upon the content that leads to knowledge enhancement. They ((i) Environmental Science (ii) English/MIL Communication) are mandatory for all discipline. AECC courses are value-based and/or skill-based and are aimed at providing hands-on-training, competencies, skill etc.

Ability Enhancement Compulsory Course (AECC): Environmental Science, English Communication/MIL Communication.

Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC) (Minimum 4): These courses may be chosen from a pool of courses designed to provide value-based and/or skill-based instruction.

Eligibility for Admission:

a) A pass in the senior Secondary (+2) Examination (Academic Stream) conducted by the H.P. Board of School Education or an examination accepted as equivalent thereto by the various bodies of the H.P. University.

i) Provided that the candidates who have passed the qualifying examination with commerce stream/Economics or Maths shall be given preference in admission to B.Com programme.

b) An applicant must not be more than 23 years (25 years for girls) of age as on 01-07-2025. However in case of overage candidates, the Vice-Chancellor may allow age relaxation upto six months. In case of scheduled Caste/ Scheduled Tribe, students relaxation upto three years is allowed as per rules.

c) An applicant failing in all subjects or having a compartment in 10+2 will not be admitted.



For The Degree:

- A regular candidate shall have to undergo the prescribed courses of study in a college affiliated to the H.P. University for a period not less than three academic years (and not more than five academic years), passed the examinations prescribed and fulfilled such conditions as have been prescribed therefore.
- There shall be no private or other category of students and shall be eligible for degree either through regular mode or through distance education mode.
- A candidate other than regular candidates shall have to undergo the prescribed courses of study International Centre for Distance Education and Open Learning (ICDEOL) H.P. University for a period not less than three academic years (and not more than five academic years), passed the examinations prescribed and fulfilled such conditions as have been prescribed therefore.

- **Students Course wise Continuous Comprehensive Assessment (CCA) and Evaluation**

All Courses (Core, Elective and Skills Courses) involve an evaluation system of students that has the following two components:-

1. **Continuous Comprehensive Assessment (CCA)** accounting for 30% of the final grade that a student gets in a course; and
2. **Annual Examination (AE)** accounting for the remaining 70% of the final grade that a student gets in a course.

i) **Continuous Comprehensive Assessment (CCA):** This would have the following components:

a) **Classroom Attendance:** Each student will have to attend a minimum of 75% Lectures/Tutorials/ Practicals. A students having less than 75% attendance will not be allowed to appear in Annual Examination (AE).

- Provided that those having between 74% and 65% attendance will apply for examination in a prescribed form accompanied by clear reason(s) for absence to the authorized functionaries.
- Provided that those having between 64% and 50% attendance will apply for exemption in a prescribed form accompanied by a Medical certificate from a Government Hospital.
- Provided that exemption from 75% attendance will be given to those participating in prescribed co-curricular activities (e.g. NSS, NCC, Youth Festivals, Sports, Rovers & Rangers etc.) to the extent of 25% (making the necessary attendance as 50% in these cases). However, the claim for this exemption should be supported by an authenticated certificate from the concerned college authorities.
- Provided further that those getting the exemptions, except for those getting exemptions for co-curricular activities, will not be

entitled for getting the CCA marks for classroom attendance as given below:

b) Classroom Attendance Incentive: Those having greater than 75% attendance (for those participating in co-curricular activities, 25% will be added to percent attendance) will be awarded CCA marks as follows:

- >75% but < 80% 1 marks
- >80% but < 85% 2 marks
- >85% but < 90% 3 marks
- >90% but < 95% 4 marks
- >95% 5 marks

c) Mid-Term Tests: There will be one mid-term test of 15 marks.

d) Seminar/Assessment/Term Paper: The remaining 10 marks of the CCA will be awarded on the basis of seminar/assignment/term paper etc.

ii) Annual Examination (AE): The remaining 70% of the final grade of the student in a course will be on the basis of an examination that will be for three hours duration and will be covering the whole syllabus of the course.

Note: Admission will be strictly on merit and roaster basis.

LEAVE RULES

GENERAL LEAVE & DUTY LEAVE RULES: Students are required to attend their classes regularly and punctually as soon as the time table is notified. Student(s) can proceed on leave only with prior permission from concerned tutor after applying in a leave proforma available in the college. Concerned tutor can recommend maximum leave up to 3 days. Senior tutor can be recommend maximum leave up to 7 days. For a long leave i.e. for more than 7 days, student must get the application recommended by the concerned tutor and sanctioned by principal before proceeding on leave. The name of student who remain absent without prior sanction of leave for six consecutive days will be struck off from the college rolls automatically. Readmission is the sole discretion of the Principal and it can be allowed within 10 days. However, under special circumstances/exceptional cases (having unavoidable situation and sufficient reason on the part of student to go on such leave). Principal can consider such leave case on the special recommendation of tutor concerned. Leave for sickness must be accompanied by a medical certificate from the competent medical authority.

Participation by the students in Sports/Cultural/NSS/Co-curricular activities/inter-college or university competitions shall be considered as duty leave (for the duration of respective competition(s) or activity) subject to the condition that it has been duly got recommended by the concerned activity in-charge (s) and approved by the Principal before the concerned of such event.

LECTURE-ATTENDANCE: The students are essentially required to be punctual and regular in their classes according to the universities rules; every student must attend at least 75% Lectures both in theory and practical separately which forms the basis of awarding internal assessment and granting permission for taking end examination. The principal can condone the shortage up to 10% in special deserving cases.

1. Students behaviour shall be marked by courtesy, dignity and respect for others. Indecent behavior towards faculty members or fellow students shall invite disciplinary action.

2. **Use of mobiles phones is strictly prohibited in the class rooms and it should be in the silent mode while the student is in the college campus.**
3. Adherence to the college rules and regulations is compulsory. Ignorance of the rules/regulation/orders as issued from time to time is no excuse. Students are expected to go through the hand book of information and college notice board(s) regularly. Defaulter shall invite penalties / disciplinary action.
4. Smoking or consumption of alcohol/drugs/narcotics/intoxicant/chewing tobacco/pan masala etc. in the college campus is strictly prohibited and punishable under law.
5. Idle sitting on wayside leading to college/parapet junction/unauthorized location in the campus will tantamount to an act of indiscipline.
6. Every student is required to carry his/her valid identity card and show the same to college authorities on demand. A student without I-Card can be asked by the college authorities to leave the campus. Habitual offenders may even be fined/handed over to police as an outsider.
7. **Torturing physically or mentally eve teasing/passing derogatory remarks or making gestures to the new entrants shall tantamount to ragging which leads to punishment under law and may lead to one's expulsion from the college Discipline Committee (CDC) and existing rules.**
8. Bringing outsiders into college campus without any valid official works by college students will be considered a violation of code of conduct.
9. Writing slogans on wall putting private notices on the college notice board, writing obscene remarks on the desks, disfiguring any piece of furniture, holding assembly or general house etc. in college premises especially without prior permission of strictly prohibited.

10. Any student found causing damage to building, furniture, electric fitting fans lab equipment etc. of college shall have to deposit the matching amount of the cost of items damaged. Besides it disciplinary action may be initiated against such defaulters.

2. किसी भी छात्र को ब्लैकबोर्ड, दीवार या फर्नीचर पर अभद्र व असंवेदीय शब्दों को लिखने का दोषी पाया जाना।
3. उद्देश्यहीन रूप से बरामदे में घूमना, शोर करना तथा अन्य कक्षाओं को बाधित करना।
4. महाविद्यालय में धूम्रपान, नशीली दवाओं तथा शराब आदि का इस्तेमाल करना।
5. परिसर में फर्नीचर या किसी भी सम्पत्ति को नुकसान पहुंचाना।

Subject: Fee Refund Policy 2024-25

आदरणीय महोदया/महोदय,

The University Grants Commission receives many representations/complaints from students/parents on the non-refund of fees by the Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) on cancellation/withdrawal of admissions.

2. Students should be allowed a full refund of fees within a specified period to enable them to opt for a course of their choice.

3. The Commission has considered the matter in its 580th meeting held on 15 May 2024, and after considering the relevant factors decided, the following fee refund policy for the academic session 2024-25:

- Notwithstanding anything contained in any guidelines/ prospectus/ notification/ schedule, a full refund of fees shall be made by the HEIs on account of all cancellations of admissions/migrations of students up to 30 September 2024 and with a deduction of not more than Rs. 1,000, as a processing fee, up to 31 October 2024.
- It shall apply to all higher education institutions, whether established or incorporated by or under a Central Act or a State Act, and every institution recognized by the University Grants Commission under clause (f) of Section 2 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956 and to all institutions deemed to be a University declared as such under Section 3 therein and to all higher education institutions affiliated to a University.
- These guidelines would also be applicable to organizations, consortiums, committees, associations, etc., constituted for the purpose of conducting counselling or processing admissions and collecting fees on behalf of participating HEIs, and the HEI concerned will be responsible for refund fees.
- For any admission schedule extending/commencing beyond/after 31 October 2024, the provisions contained in the UGC Notification issued in October 2018 on Refund of Fees and Non-Retention of Original Certificates shall apply (reproduced below for ready reference):

Category	Percentage of Refund of fees*	Point of time when notice of withdrawal of admission is received in the HEI
(1)	100%	15 days or more before the formally notified last date of admission
(2)	90%	Less than 15 days before the formally notified last date of admission
(3)	80%	15 days or less after the formally notified last date of admission
(4)	50%	30 days or less, but more than 15 days after formally notified last date of admission
(5)	00%	More than 30 days after formally notified last date of admission

- e. This policy will remain in force for subsequent academic sessions until the issuance of a revised policy by the UGC.

4. It may also be noted that the UGC has notified the Redressal of Grievances of Students Regulations, 2023, wherein *"delay in, or denial of, the refund of fees due to a student who withdraws admission within the time mentioned in the prospectus, subject to guidelines, if any, issued by the Commission, from time to time"* has been defined as one of the grievances.

5. The Higher Education Institutions are requested to ensure compliance with the fee refund policy for the academic session 2024-25 and redress any grievance by the provisions of the University Grants Commission (Redressal of Grievances of Students) Regulations, 2023.

6. Any HEI violating the provisions of UGC Fee Refund Policy 2024-25 shall be liable for punitive action as notified in Clause 5 of the UGC Notification on Refund of Fees and Non-Retention of Original Certificates issued in October 2018.

Ragging means any act, conduct or practice by which dominate power of senior students is brought to bear on the freshly enrolled or in any way considered junior by other students which involves physical and psychological assault or threat to other students or use of force or violation of dignity and honor of such students or expose students to ridicule effect their self-esteem or entail verbal abuse, aggression, indecent gestures and obscene behavior. Any students found involved in ragging will be punished strictly by the college authorities and such penalization may include

- Expulsion from the college
- Suspension from the classes
- Fine with a public apology
- With holding scholarships or other benefits
- Debarring from the representation in events
- Legal proceeding under criminal law shall be initiated. It includes imprisonments for a term which may extend to three year or with fine which may extend to fifty thousand or with both.
